iPad Pro (12.9 inch) (5th Generation):

Chrome	No images
Edge	No images
Firefox	Images displayed
Safari	Images displayed

iPhone 14 Pro:

Chrome	No images
Edge	No images
Firefox	No images
Safari	No image

As I can't reproduce this behaviour on desktop versions of those browsers by reducing their windows' dimensions, is it probably unrelated to viewport size-dependent CSS rules?

One of the reasons for my visit was to see if your recent email Press Release (may I suggest that Media Release is a better term) had been published on your website, but sadly, the most recent one dates to the 6th of August 2021!
